The composition of the tuition for the academic year 2021-2022

The basic tuition fees 25% coverage is 3496.75 NIS. This amount is indexed to inflation using the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for June of 2021 (published in 15 July 2021).

The tuition fees 25% coverage for international PhD student enrolled to stage 1 is 5,288 NIS

In addition, the following payments are added to the basic tuition fees:

1. Security payments – 535 NIS indexed to inflation using the CPI of June 2021.
2. Welfare payments –336 NIS indexed to inflation using the CPI of June 2021.
Note that this fee is not mandatory and will be subtracted upon request.
3. Furthermore, tuition for international students is 25% higher than the basic tuition fees.

If your payments of tuition fees are done by overseas bank transactions or by non-Israeli credit card, kindly note the following:

1. Make sure *to initiate the payment at least 2 weeks prior to due date* in order to avoid probable delays or obstacles in your student permissions.
2. Following payment, *always inform the school secretary by mail, attach the bank transfer confirmation and include your full name and student number in the mail text or subject*. We will make sure it comes to place and closes your open debt through a direct interaction with the tuition department.
3. If you were recently enrolled and already in possession of an Israeli mobile phone number and a local mail address, please *contact promptly the school secretary and ask to update this within the system*.
